

SOUTH POINT SCHOOL

ADMISSION POLICY

FOR CLASSES NURSERY I & NURSERY II : ACADEMIC SESSION 2012-13

1. Minimum age of a child will be 3+ for admission to Nursery I and 4+ for Nursery II. A child born between 01.04.2008 and 31.03.2009 is eligible for admission to Nursery I and a child born between 01.04.2007 and 31.03.2008 is eligible for admission to Nursery II.

2. The applicants will be categorized as follows:

- i. Sibling – Applicants who have their own brother or sister (not cousin) presently studying in South Point School or South Point High School. The School considers it to be a very important factor for admission as the parents of existing students form a bonding with the school.
- ii. Alumni – For the children of ex-students (mother/father) of South Point High School.
- iii. Resident of Neighbourhood – For those who stay under the following pincodes:

iv. General – All those who do not fall in any of the above categories

v. Management – Admission to be granted at the school management's discretion.

3. The general public will be informed through advertisement/notification in the newspapers/school notice board/school website about the commencement of the admission process.

4. Prospectus and Registration forms will be available from the School Office against a stipulated amount for a specified period, with the objective to inform the parents about various activities, facilities provided in the School and the admission criteria of the School.
5. Parents are required to submit self-attested copies of the following documents with the registration form:
 - a. Birth Certificate of the candidate issued by the Municipal Corporation or other competent authority
 - b. Residence Proof (Passport, Ration Card, Electricity Bill, Voter I Card or Driving Licence of either parent)
 - c. Sibling's ID Card or previous year's progress report (in case the child is a brother/sister of an existing student of SPS /SPHS)
 - d. Parent's Madhyamik Marksheet/Certificate, in case he and/or she is an alumni of South Point High School
6. The Registration Form will not be transferable. If any information on the Registration Form is found to be incomplete, false or incorrect, the application is liable to be rejected without intimation. If two forms are received in a child's name, only one form will be considered, at the discretion of the School.
7. The registration form along with documents in a sealed envelope, is to be deposited in the School Office in the boxes provided for this purpose for a specified period.
8. Selection of candidates for admission will be done by the School, applying a random selection method or on lottery basis. There will be no profiling of parents based on their educational qualifications or any other criteria, nor will the child be subjected to any screening procedure.
9. First list of selected candidates in each category will be published on the date notified. Further lists will be published depending on the vacancies, applying the above selection method.
10. If an applicant falls under more than one category, the applicant will be considered under each category in the order of priority decided by the School, e.g., if a candidate falls in the category of sibling, alumni and resident of neighbourhood, then he will be considered for random selection first in the sibling category. If not selected he will be considered in the alumni category and still if not selected, he will be reconsidered in the 'resident of neighbourhood' category, and lastly, if still not selected, then his application will be considered in the general category, depending on vacancies.
11. The admission process has been carefully designed to provide equal opportunity to all the applicants and to maintain transparency in the admission procedure.
12. This admission policy is applicable only to fee-paying students.
