Dear Guardians,

You may be aware that the State Government has recently announced the revision of pay structure of teaching and non-teaching staff of schools following the West Bengal Services (Revision of Pay and Allowances) Rules 2019. In the past, the school has always sought to align the pay scales of its staff members with those applicable to the State Government employees. The Managing Committee of the School has accordingly proposed to implement the new pay structure for all eligible members of staff.

You are also aware that South Point School is a private unaided school and does not receive any grant-in-aid whatsoever from the State Government or any other bodies. It is completely dependant on the fees paid by the guardians for meeting its expenditure.

Under the circumstances, we are constrained to inform you that there will be an additional enhancement in the fee structure for the Academic Session 2020-21. We must reiterate that it has been and will be the endeavour of the School to continue to provide quality education to its pupils at affordable costs to the guardian. Thus, the school has also tried to curtail and rationalise on other expenses, such that the financial impact of the revisions is minimised to the extent possible.
