Classes I, II & III

Dear Parents

We warmly welcome our pupils to the new Academic Session, 2022-23, which will begin on Monday, April 4, 2022. We eagerly look forward to the beginning of a new session and having our children back in school! We are happy to announce that we will continue with our hybrid mode of teaching-learning till the summer vacation, and children will attend both online and offline classes.

The schedule for offline and online classes has been given below. The new session will begin with online classes. The first day of offline classes for II and III will be Friday, April 8, and that for Class I will be Tuesday, April 12. Henceforth, offline classes will be conducted for all the 3 classes twice a week.

The School will continue to follow Covid protocols in order to safeguard the health of the pupils. This includes the filling up of **Health Declaration Forms** by the parents of pupils attending classes at School. These will need to be filled up the evening prior to attending classes physically.

The School Bus Service will be available for pupils as earlier.

Once again, to facilitate smooth and safe entry, dispersal and running of classes, we need your full cooperation, dear parents. Kindly note the following details and ensure that they are strictly adhered to:

1. A fresh format for ID cards will be specified in MS Teams and all instructions will be clearly given in class. Please prepare/print the ID cards, using the exact dimensions and format specified. The ID Card has to be put in a jacket and attached to a cord (Red – for Morning Session; Blue – for Afternoon Session). The ID card should be clearly visible.

- 2. Each child is advised to wear two disposable surgical masks labelled with his / her name and must carry an extra labelled mask in the bag. Please note that wearing of mask in the school premises is mandatory. However, in case a student has a medical issue and finds it difficult to wear a mask, they can seek permission for the same.
- 3. Pupils are to carry their own tiffin, water bottles and stationery items, to ensure that they do not have to share anything with their peer group. The school canteen will be out of bounds for the children. Visits to the washroom will be strictly monitored.
- 4. All pupils should wear their regular school uniform.
- 5. The routine and other relevant notices will be shared through the School App.
- 6. In order to maintain social distancing, each section has been divided into two groups, Group 1 & 2.

GROUP 1: Roll Nos. 01 – 30; GROUP 2: Roll No.31 onwards

Section Groups and other finer details will be shared by the Class Teachers during online classes.

- 7. All entry/exit gates, waiting areas and other strategic positions within the school premises will be manned to ensure smooth monitoring of all movement and activities. We request you to avoid overcrowding near the school gates and in the courtyard.
- 8. School gates will be opened for entry 20 minutes before the commencement of classes. Dispersal will be from the courtyard.
