Dear Parents.

The overwhelming response in attendance of your wards for physical classes has been really encouraging. Therefore, we are happy to inform you that it has been decided to resume physical classes in a full-fledged manner, twice a week, on Wednesdays and Fridays, with regular school timings, as was followed prior to the pandemic, from the week beginning April 25, 2022.

Your wards will continue to have online classes on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays.

All entry/exit gates, waiting areas and other strategic positions within the school premises will be manned to ensure smooth monitoring of all movement and activities. Hence we strongly discourage overcrowding of guardians near the school gates and in the courtyard.

School gates will be opened for entry 20 minutes before the commencement of classes.
