## **NOTICE : NURSERY TO CLASS V**

Dear Parents,

We are now happy to note that your wards have gradually settled down into the normal school routine. However, it has been observed that though our pupils are good at verbal communication, they are still diffident in the matter of written work. Their presentation of work too has been affected.

At present, teachers are gauging the progress of the children through the regular written work done in class as this is helping them get instant feedback on whether the concepts taught have been assimilated by the pupils, and take additional practice lessons for further improvement, if needed. More time is being devoted to drilling of concepts and making the children practise reading the questions, understanding the rubrics and writing answers within the stipulated time in the expected format. Emphasis is being laid upon regular short written class work to be completed within a fixed time. This is helping the children are being taught the importance of presentation of work in accordance with the expected format.

Since we are focussing more on practice written work, it has been decided that only one report card will be issued to the children at the end of the Final Term.

The regular Parent – Teacher Meeting will, of course, be held to apprise you on the progress of your wards.

Although marked assessments are not being held at present, we will soon be starting with the same in the month of September as the children are gradually regaining confidence in writing within the stipulated time in the expected format of a formal assessment. We are also hoping to hold the Final Term Block Tests for the children of Classes IV and V as we are sure they will be fully prepared to handle full-length formal tests by then.
