



## Athletic meet

Performance and prizes marked the two-day Biennial Athletic Meet of South Point at the Gitanjali Stadium, Kolkata. Jag Mohan, IPS, Director General, Department of Fire & Emergency Services, West Bengal, and Anjana Sinha, IPS, Director, National Industrial Security Academy, Hyderabad, graced the occasion on the two days respectively.



On Day-1, there were drill, yoga and karate displays, besides many track events. About 900 children from Nursery to Class V took part.
