## NOTICE: CLASSES III to V

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Skolaro app/portal for guardians was successfully launched by the School and we are grateful to the guardians for their cooperation, despite some initial teething problems. It is because of this new app/portal that communication with parents about lessons and assignments is being done in a smooth fashion now.

It is now the turn of our students to start using their own log in credentials on the app/portal, primarily to send back assignments to their teachers as well as to take quizzes etc., which cannot be done through the parents' credentials. We would strongly advise that log in / access to the app should be under supervision of parents.

The students' portal can be accessed through a browser on a computer or mobile device by visiting [www.skolaro.com](http://www.skolaro.com) and clicking on "Login". We urge all students to start using the app also. It is available to download from Google Play / Apple Store carrying the name "Skolaro". Students can log in to the app/portal with their user name in the form of xx-xxxx.spk where xx-xxxx stands for the Student ID.

For example, if the Student ID is 10-1234, then the User ID will be 10-1234.spk

For the first time log ins, the default password has been set as date of birth in ddmmyyy format preceded by a "s".

For example, if date of birth of a student is April 10, 2008, then the password will be s10042008. The password MUST be reset after the first login.

In case some guardians have only one device on which they are able to download the school app, then you will have to log in and log out to access the parents and the students sections as and when needed.
