NOTICE : CLASSES I TO V

Dear Parents,

We hope that your wards have settled down in their new classes.

Since the menace of the pandemic still looms large, we are presently unable to start physical classes. Considering the difficult circumstances, we are planning to continue with the virtual mode of teaching until normalcy returns and the government allows schools to reopen. We have been periodically uploading worksheets for various subjects. You have also been helping your children in turning in their work to enable our teachers to correct them and give a feedback of the same.

For holistic learning, both teaching and testing have to go hand in hand. We will continue to upload worksheets/ quizzes on MS Teams, most of which will be treated as practice work. However, for assessments and quizzes which will be taken for evaluation purposes, you will be given a week's notice so that your ward is adequately prepared.

Kindly note that in the academic session 2021-2022, we will have two terms. Since the evaluation process will be a continuous one, students will be marked on class performance as well. This evaluation system has been adopted mainly to help parents and teachers assess what has been assimilated by each child. We also propose to hold Block Tests for Classes IV and V. The Block Tests may be parent-proctored if they are held virtually. Pupils of Classes II to V will be assessed on project work too.

A Report Card will be issued at the end of each term, which will reflect your ward's academic progress. No ranks will be awarded this year too. We assure you that the assessment process will be simple and we request you not to be anxious about the same.

Under these unusual and unpredictable circumstances, the collaboration between you parents and us teachers has taken a more meaningful turn, and based on that strength we hope to make the continuous evaluation process a complete success just as we did last year. You, dear parents, have cooperated with us at every step and in order to assess the learning outcome of your wards without the direct supervision of our teachers, we humbly appeal to you to supervise these assessments in a spirit that will uphold the firm faith that we have reposed in you. Kindly guide your children to do the assessments themselves without any external help. Only then, will our evaluation be a fair judgement of your child's own work. After all, our final goal is to nurture these young minds into becoming responsible citizens of the future.
