Circular for Parents / Guardian of the pupils of Class X (2022-23)
Sub: Admission to Class XI for the academic session 2023-24

You are well aware that your ward is being prepared for AISSE 2023, following the guidelines of CBSE. Being parents, you are also waiting for the School to declare its admission policy for Class XI (2023-24).

To begin the process of admitting its pupils, it's important that the School knows the choice of streams / subjects / session (wherever applicable) for its pupils. Hence, link to the Option Form is being provided below:

The link may be accessed using the O365 email ID and password of the pupils which have been provided to them by the School in the edu.in domain. It is mandatory for all pupils of Class X, interested in continuing their education in Class XI at South Point High School to exercise their choice of stream, session and subjects via the Option Form. The link to the form will be posted in **"22-23-Class-10-All Parents" group in Skolaro**. Since, the form can be submitted only ONCE, please ensure that you do not require any further changes after the form is submitted. For two siblings trying to fill the Option Form for Class XI, the two different O365 credentials of the two pupils must be used. **The Form will remain active till 3:00 pm on Tuesday, November 15, 2022.** Those who fail to submit the option form in time cannot be considered for admission under any circumstances.

A list of pupils earmarked to write the Admission Test / Eligibility Test will be published through Skolaro in the **"22-23-Class-10-All Parents" group at 5 pm on Thursday, November 17, 2022.**

We would like to inform you about the criteria that will be followed to select pupils for admission to Class XI, Academic Session 2023-24. Please note that due to limited number of seats, all pupils cannot be admitted to Class XI, especially to the streams / subjects / sessions of their choice.

Pupils who opt to study under any stream (Science, Commerce or Humanities) will be considered for provisional admission on the basis of their performance in all relevant Internal Assessments of Class IX (2021-2022) and all Internal Assessments held for Class X (2022 – 23), conducted till date, in physical mode at School. In addition to these, pupils opting to study under the Science Stream will write the **Admission Test** and those opting to study Mathematics under the Humanities Stream will write the **Eligibility Test** from **8 am on Saturday, November 19, 2022.** The Admission Test has a major stake in creation of the Merit List, but Eligibility Test is only a qualifying exam giving a pupil eligibility to study Mathematics, under Humanities Stream. Disciplinary record of the pupil will also be considered for granting admission.

A Merit List based on the aforesaid criteria will be published on **Wednesday, December 07, 2022 at 3:00 pm**. The Merit List will be uploaded on the School website in the "Admission to Class XI" section. Pupils / parents are not required to come to School physically to check the Merit List as the lists will also be posted through Skolaro in the same group "**22-23-Class-10-All Parents**". The admission process of the selected pupils will begin from **Thursday, December 08, 2022**. Parents are to note that the admission process will be deemed to have been completed only after the Admission Form has been filled and the required fee has been collected. Seats cannot be reserved unless payment is received, and if found otherwise will be offered to those whose names appear in the consequent lists of the three streams. Parents may also note that payments will be accepted by the School via demand draft as well as through debit / credit cards at the School fee counter. If cards are used for fee payment, it is advisable that parents check the daily usage limit of the same from their respective banks.

The details of the subjects offered, and the different combinations of subjects allowed in Class XI, in Morning and Afternoon sessions is attached herewith for a ready reference. It is also available on the School website in the "Admission to Class XI" section. It may please be noted that a subject included in the list may not be offered, if a minimum number of pupils do not opt to study the subject in Class XI.

Kindly note that admission granted will be provisional and conditional, as pupils selected for admission are compulsorily required to appear in Practice Test 1 and Practice Test 2 and score reasonably well to prove their eligibility to study in Class XI. The provisional admissions will be confirmed subject to scoring at least 60% in the aggregate in AISSE 2023. We request all parents / guardian to take note of the above information and exercise the option for Stream Selection by filling in the Option Form.

The provisional admission process is expected to be completed by **December 2022**. Provisionally admitted pupils will be notified in due course about the commencement of Class XI.
